Recreational opportunities abound with the Tasman Sea on our doorstep and

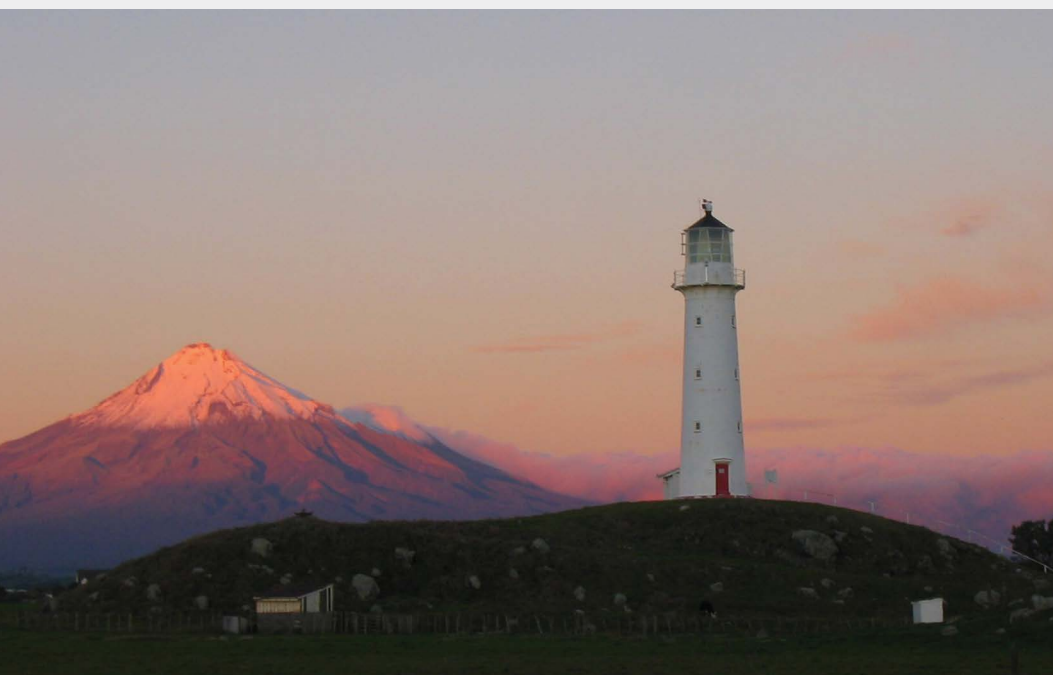

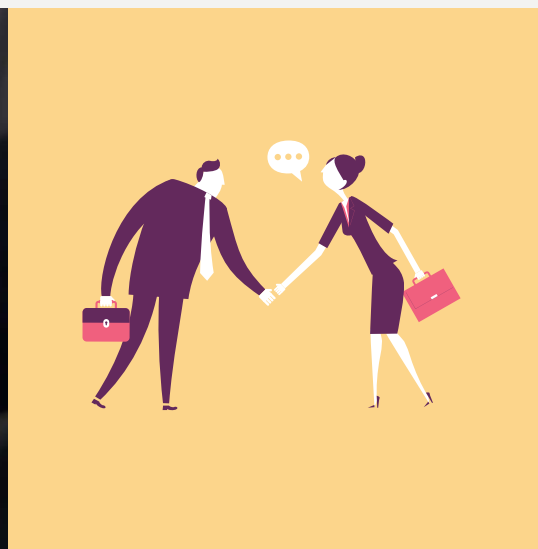

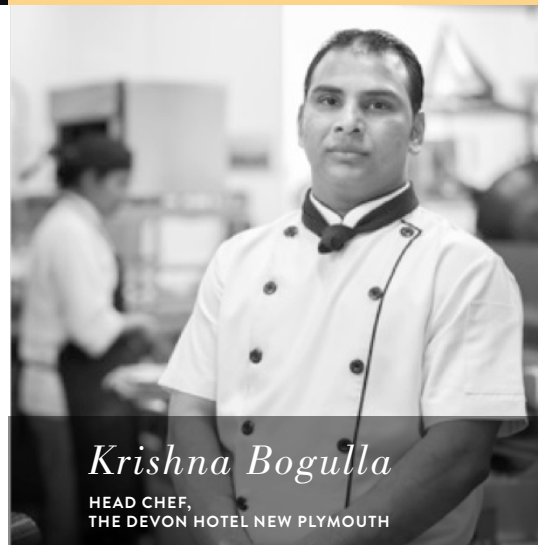

Or pay a visit to one of the last working lighthouses in New Zealand, the Cape Egmont lighthouse.

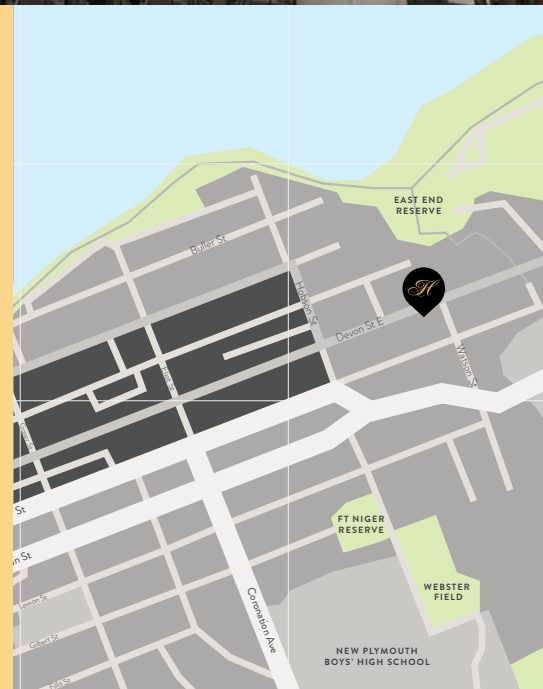
From world-class surf breaks to a perfectly formed volcanic peak, Taranaki offers countless opportunities for adventure.

SUSTAINABILITY

The Devon Hotel recognises the importance of our role in protecting and enhancing the environment for future generations.

The Hotel undertakes a pro-active approach in recycling our general and food waste products. All our green waste is composted. The hotel was recognised for our efforts by our Council and were used as a case study to promote waste minimisation.

Our team always try's to buy local to reduce our carbon footprint and whenever possible re-use packaging.

Ecolab has worked closely with the hotel to reduce our environmental impact by using low temperature biodegradable products. They have reduced the amount of water and electricity, whilst maintaining our high standards.

Structural renovations incorporate the latest technologies with heat pumps, LED lighting and reduced flow of water in showers.

The hotel operates the Spa and Pool by solar power for heating, and all the hotel boilers are rated as energy efficient.

All bottles are fully recycled in all areas of the hotel. The bottles are separated into the different types by colour. All cardboard and paper is recycled by all departments.

Front Office has an additional process for recycling all printer cartridges.

For conferences requesting water coolers, the hotel provides glass water glasses and no longer utilizes disposal plastic cups.

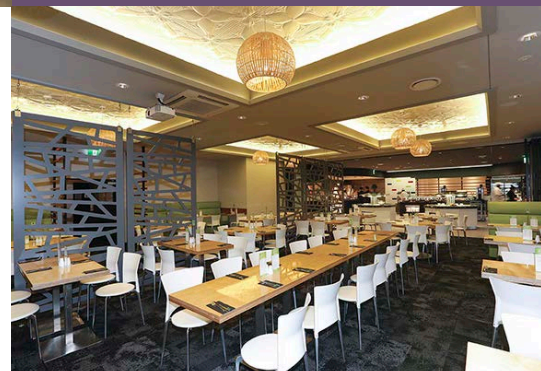

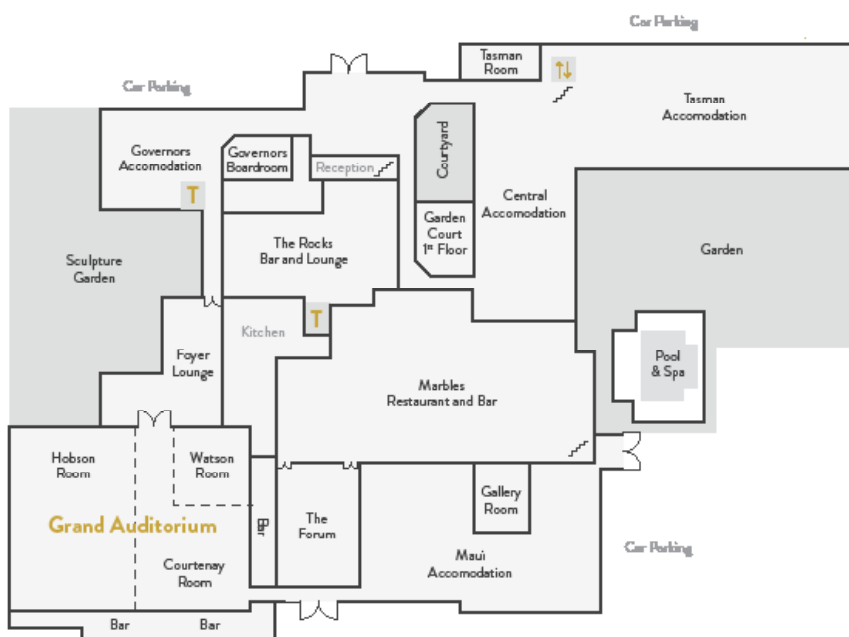

There is so much to do in Taranaki. Whether it's an active outdoor adventure, exploring the region through guided tours, discovering local villages and artists through to coffee tasting.

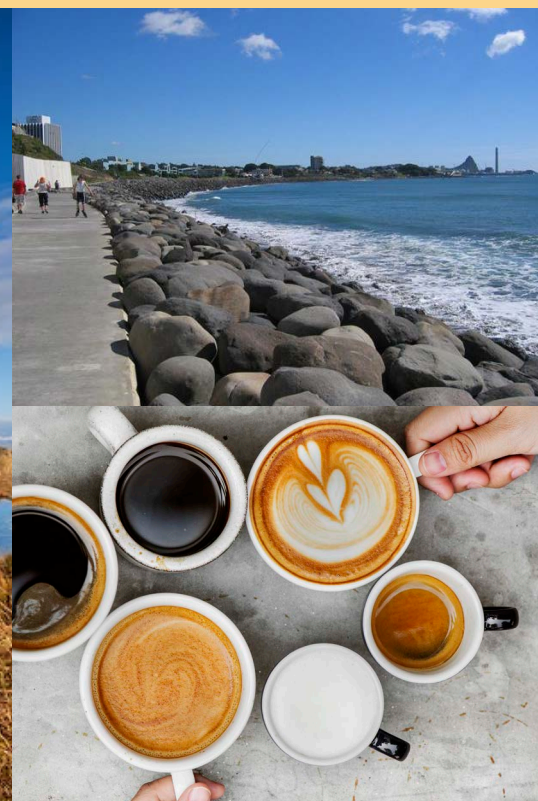

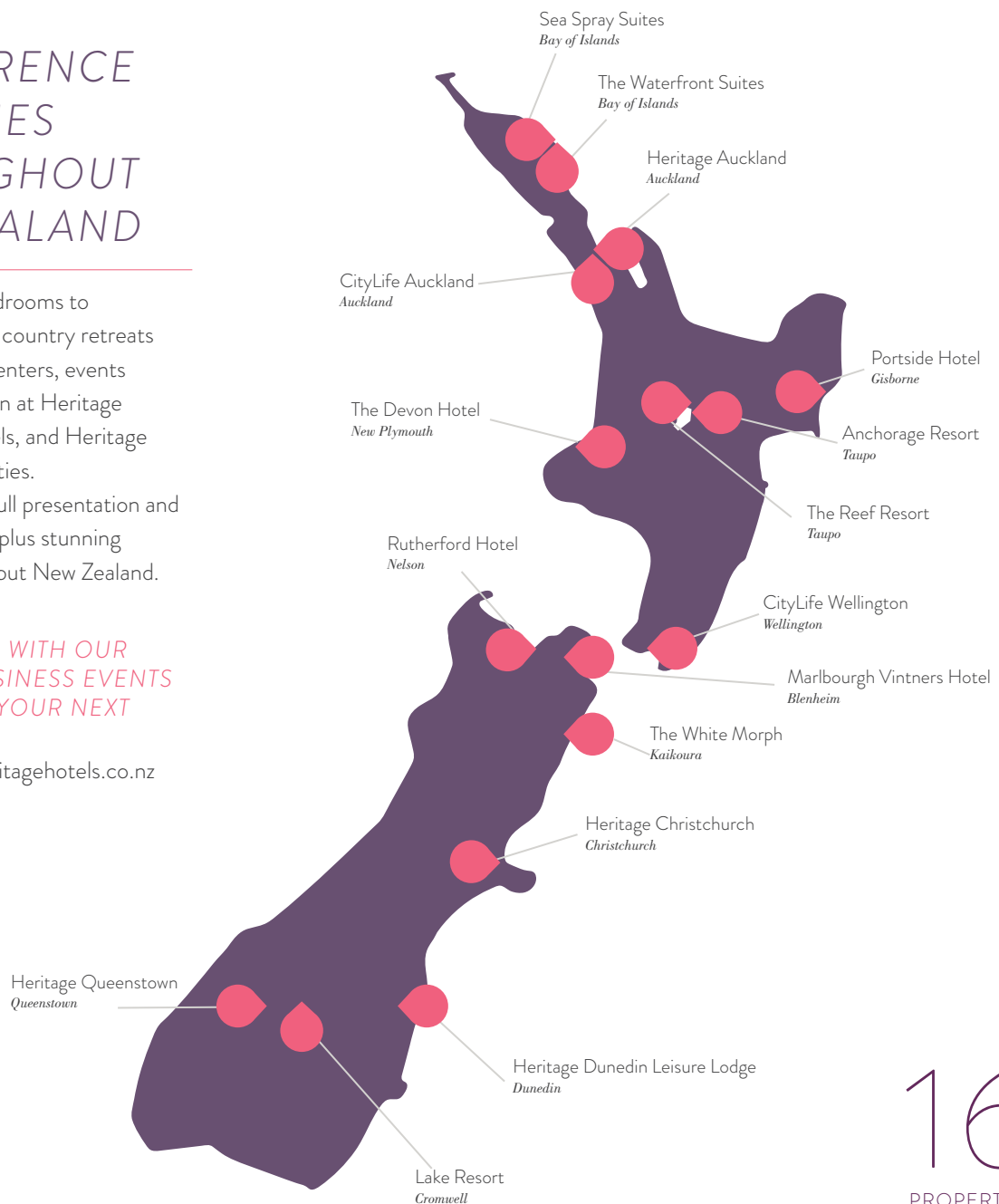
